

Installing Telnet Support for Windows 95 and NT® Users of DQ Online

Use the procedures in this document to install Telnet support using the Anzio Lite™ version of Telnet and Microsoft Windows 95 and Windows NT. Native browser support for starting a Telnet session from Internet Explorer is provided by the Windows 98 operating system.

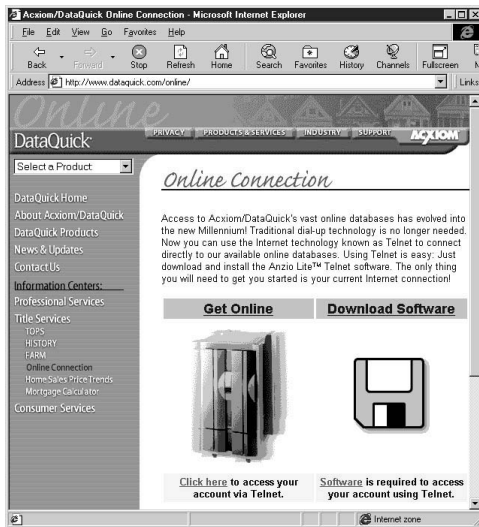
The procedures in this document apply to the Anzio Lite version of Telnet ONLY.

For information on starting and using Windows 98 Telnet sessions, see the Windows 98 online Help.

Installing Telnet Support

To install Anzio Lite Telnet support:

1. From the DataQuick Online Connection (<http://www.dataquick.com/online>), click the **Download Software** link to reach the file download area where you can download and install telnet software support.



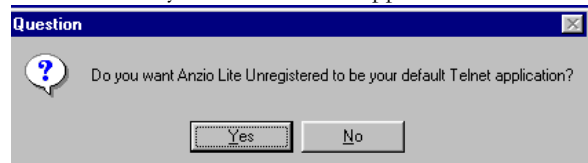
2. From the setup page, click the **Download Now** link to begin downloading the telnet application.

Download and installation times will vary depending on connection type, speed, and operating system.

Note: The Anzio Lite telnet application allows you to configure Anzio Lite as your default telnet application during installation. Tell the Installation Wizard no, if

you do not want to configure Anzio Lite as your default telnet application during installation.

3. From File Download dialog, select **Run this program from its current location** and click **OK**.
4. Click **Yes** when asked **Do you want to install and run “anzlusetup.exe”** from online.dataquick.com.
5. Read the Software License Agreement and click **Yes** to continue your installation of Anzio Lite.
6. Enter your **Name** and **Company** name when prompted and click **Next**.
7. Select a **Destination Folder** and **Program Folder** when prompted and click **Next**.
8. (Optional) Click **Yes** when asked if you want Anzio Lite to be your default telnet application.



*Important: If you do not want Anzio Lite to be your default telnet application, click **No** when asked this question.*

9. Click **Finish** to complete the installation process.

Starting Anzio Lite Telnet for the First Time

When you start the Anzio Lite version of Telnet for the first time you may be asked for some preliminary setup information.

If prompted to supply a Host name or IP port address, enter online.dataquick.com as the host name or IP port address. Select the VT100 as your terminal type and choose the communication method applicable to your system.

Host Name/IP Port Address **Default Terminal Type**

- online.dataquick.com • VT100

Logging On to DQ Online

To log onto DQ Online using Telnet:

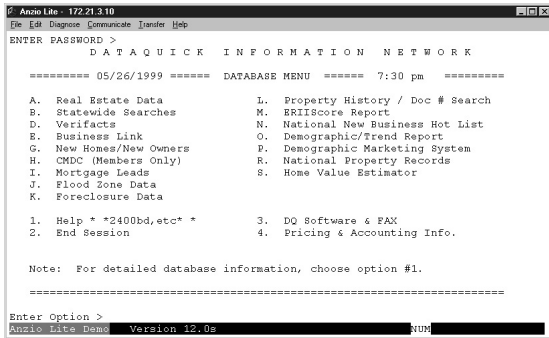
1. Start your internet/web browser (Internet Explorer or Netscape) and log onto the Internet.

- Click into the **Address** field of your internet browser and type *telnet://online.dataquick.com*.



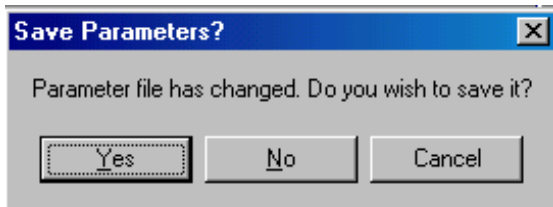
*Note: An Anzio Lite countdown and registration screen will appear for a few seconds each time you start an **unregistered** version of the Anzio Lite application. The countdown and registration screen goes away when you register your copy of the Anzio Lite.*

- Press ENTER to launch your Telnet session.
- Type your **Logon ID** and **Password** when prompted and press ENTER to display the main menu.



Ending Telnet Sessions

When ending a Telnet session, you may be asked if you would like to save parameter settings. Anzio Lite recognizes when you make changes to your current system and/or session parameters that affect Telnet sessions. Choosing “Yes” when asked to save parameters preserves your current system and/or session parameters for future Telnet sessions.



To end a Telnet session:

- From the database main menu, choose **End Session**.

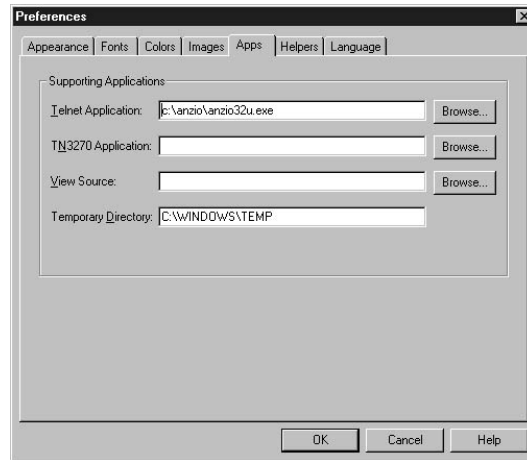
Note: Anzio Lite will prompt you to save parameters after installing and running Anzio Lite for the first time. It is important to save parameters after successfully installing Anzio Lite. User-defined parameters and defaults do not take effect until you save them.

Important Information for Users of Netscape 3.0

If Netscape does not launch telnet sessions from your browser after you have installed Anzio Lite, use the following procedure to configure Netscape.

To configure Netscape to launch telnet sessions:

- Start Netscape and go to the Preferences window (usually found on the Options menu).



- Select the **Apps** tab and type *c:\anzio\anzio32u.exe* in the **Telnet Application** field.
- Click **OK**.

Network and WAN Installation

If you encounter difficulties using Telnet after installing Anzio Lite, check with your Network Administrator or Information Systems Department to ensure that Telnet access has been enabled (port 23).
